Coming by with an update about books - - from your home, from your school, and public library which have been placed, or are being processed for placement in secondary schools in East Africa.

This month, the continued involvement at Bookfriends' warehouse centers around completion of the next container of about 20,000 books to schools near Morogoro, in central Tanzania. Each school will receive hundreds of books - a well-rounded curriculum appropriate to each school's individual needs. Additionally, each school will receive a library of books, fiction and non-fiction. These books, of great variety, will serve to broaden students' minds and begin building foundations for their personhood and how they can use their talents effectively.

The last container of books shipped is now at the port of Tanga in NE Tanzania and will soon be transported to a warehouse in Moshi from which the pallets of books will be transported to ten secondary schools. Among the many heart-warming experiences for all of us at Bookfriends, this is the time that is the most exciting - for the teenagers in those ten schools will soon have the books they have been awaiting, i.e. a full curriculum of textbooks and thousands of varied library books.
